# F. Grades



Students can pick up their grade reports after **3 p.m. on Tuesday, Oct. 21, in the IELI Student Lounge**. If you come to pick-up your grades on Wednesday, Oct. 21, please go to room 220. Grades will be held until all Fall 1 bills are paid in full.

If a student needs further explanation of a grade (either passing or not passing), the student must follow these steps on Tuesday when grades are distributed:

- Sign up in the Main Office (ISB 211) for an appointment to talk with a committee of teachers about the grade. **Grade appeal panels take place on Wed., Oct. 21 from 9 –11 a.m. and 1:30—3 p.m.**
- DO NOT make an appointment with the Curriculum Coordinators or the Director. They will only become involved in discussions of grade reports at the direct request of the teachers.
- When the committee of teachers talks with you, they will look at your grades and answer any questions you have. If an error is discovered, they will talk to the Curriculum Coordinator about correcting the situation.
- Bring your class grade reports to the grade appeal meeting.

# G. UNT Homecoming

## What is Homecoming?

Homecoming is a tradition that has been taking place at UNT since the 1930s. Most American universities have a Homecoming celebration in the fall. It is a time when alumni come back to the university for the weekend and students show their school spirit. During Homecoming Week, there are many special, fun events on campus for students. Be sure to keep your eyes and ears open for them.

## What happens during Homecoming?

Here's the schedule of Homecoming events:

### Friday, Oct. 16:

**6:45 p.m.** Spirit March. Starts at Greek Row and goes past Kerr Hall to the Athletic Center in the Mean Green Village.

**8:15 p.m.** Bonfire and Yell Contest at the Athletic Center.

These are pep rallies to get people excited about UNT and the football game on Saturday.



### Saturday, Oct. 17:

**1 p.m.** Parade. Starts at the Denton Square and travels across Hickory Street and North Texas Blvd.

**3 p.m.** Tailgating begins in the parking lot of Fouts Field. There will be lots of tents giving away free things, be sure to stop by.

**6 p.m.** UNT football game vs. Florida Atlantic at Fouts Field. Free with Student ID.
